



Fall 2020 Player Eligibility

The fall 2020 season participation guidelines for East Indy Trailblazers soccer players are as follows:

1. Code of Conduct: All players must agree to abide by the club's Player Code of Conduct.
2. Education: Throughout the entire season, players must be actively receiving a homeschooled education which is primarily directed and provided by the player's parent(s) or guardian(s). Players who take one or more classes at a formal educational institution (college, public school, private school) may also be eligible to participate at the discretion of club leadership. ***However, a player is ineligible to participate if any one of the following is true, regardless of the player's age:***
 - a. ***Formally graduated from high school***
 - b. ***Completed of high school course of study***
 - c. ***Received high school diploma***
 - d. ***Passed the Test Assessing Secondary Completion (TASC), formerly the General Educational Development (GED) test***
3. Dedicated Participation: Throughout the entire season, players may not participate in practices or games as a member of another homeschool, public school, private school, or other organized soccer team.
4. Maximum Age:
 - a. Varsity - No older than 19 years as of November 1, 2020
 - b. Junior High - Born in 2006 or after
 - c. U12 - Born in 2009 or after
5. Minimum Age:
 - a. Varsity - No younger than 13 years as of October 1, 2020
 - b. Junior High - Born in 2008 or before
 - c. U12 - Born in 2011 or earlier

IMPORTANT NOTE: East Indy Trailblazers participate in multiple tournaments during the Fall season. Every effort has been made to ensure that all eligible players will also be able to participate in those tournaments. However, tournament eligibility rules are set forth by tournament administrators; although any changes or exceptions to those rules are beyond the control of East Indy Trailblazers leadership, players and parents must understand and agree to act with integrity regarding those rules, even if they are precluded from participation in those tournaments.
